It provides a forum to showcase talents of young students in the college. The whole events create an arena for young talented managers to compete, succeed, and make remarkable moments. Actually four events were conducted in the fest namely “TRINETRA” the Mobile Photography, “ATHARVA” the Mega quiz, “NAVIGATOR”, the Treasure Hunt and “ARGO”, the Product Augmentation and Marketing Game. The Program started at 9.30 a.m. with the flag off done by the principal at the auditorium.

TRINETRA (Mobile Spot Photography)

The Commerce Department of Alphonsa College Thiruvambady organized a mobile photography competition named “TRINETRA” on behalf of inter-departmental management fest. The main purpose of this competition was to identify the photographic skills of students and select best photographer of our college. It was a creative event participants got an opportunity to capture the best on the topic “Men at Work”. The competition was started at sharp 10 a.m. at college campus with the explanation of rules and regulation to be followed while checking the photographs and the Judgement criteria to the contestants. Mr. Sebastian Cherian (Head of Department English), Mr. Robin George (Faculty of Department English), Ms. Ajeena Joseph (Faculty of Department Psychology) were the judges of the competition. The entry fee for the contest was Rs. 50 per student and winner will be able to capture Rs. 500. Among 33 participants Muhammad Midlaj (Ist year CA) bagged the first prize.
