The various aims of the club are to create awareness among the students about the need of environmental Protection, to prepare and organize student`s participation for preservation and conservation of environment, to make Clean and Green Campus, to use different media such as audio, visual, posters, seminar, workshop, Guest Lecture and competitions for spreading messages concerning environment and to create awareness among Society regarding environmental protection and to create a pollution free environment.

World environment day was celebrated in a unique way in the college. The theme of the year was *Ecosystem Restoration*. Students planted the saplings in their home. The message of the day was delivered by Ann Maria Joseph of 1<sup>st</sup> English . A thought provoking and creative video presentation was done by the members of the club .

On 5th of June 2021 on world environment day. NGGF<sup>n</sup> conducted the STUDENT GREEN VIDEO CHALLENGE , where in which 2nd year B.com finance Student ABIN JOHN MATHEW was participated on the topic " only one earth ".The instant video created by Abin John Mathew during lockdown for the STUDENT GREEN VIDEO CHALLENGE as rated by a panel of judges for entry to the final round of the contest is VERY MUCH APPRECIATED and received a certificate.
