Alphonsa College Thiruvambady identifies the pupil who needs special attention through the CIE Cell, tutoring and mentoring schemes. The teachers are happy to help those academically weaker students to score better results in examinations. The details of the remedial classes organized in Alphonsa College Thiruvambady as follows:

Remedial Programmes

ACT identifies the students who need special attention in academic matters and provides them bridge courses, special coaching, experiential learning platforms, special classes and tutorials. They weaker students are psychologically supported and the reasons for their incompetency are unearthed and solved. These programmes are designed in such a manner that the students feel confident to compete with the forerunners in academia.

The remedial coaching programme envisions to support weak learners in different subjects and provides them more focused teaching support to enhance their qualitative and quantitative subject knowledge, academic skills and linguistic proficiency. Faculties also get a chance of effective mentoring of such under privileged groups. The main facets of remedial coaching carried out in our college are well organized classes, revision classes, perfect training and, previous years question paper discussions etc. These strategies have facilitated us to upraise our pass percentage to a great extent.

Details of Remedial Programmes for the academic year 2021-2022

In each semester before the commencement of exams special classes are arranged as revision classes for helping the students to prepare for the exms.

Very weak students are identified on the basis of class performance and arranged intensive coaching after the classes. Students were asked to sit back after the classes for studying. Students were divided into different

groups and a leader for each group had been selected . Team leader usually discuss important topics taken in the classes and help weaker students to study well. Each TL had been entrusted with 4 or 5 students each. This arrangement was there in BBA and BCom classes.
