















Graph IV: Students have only average opinion about the structure of the curriculum to meet programme or course outcome. 67% students give average opinion and 33% give good opinion about the same.





Graph III: student's feedback about the size of the curriculum show different picture. Out of the total student feedback 75% of the students have good opinion. But 25% students give


only satisfactory comments regarding the size of the curriculum. It indicates that size of the curriculum is adequate in terms of load to the students.




