## **Department of Commerce**

Graph I: First question asked to students as part of feedback is about the potential of the curriculum to update knowledge and perspective in the subject area. Results shows that most of them have good and very good opinion about the same. 44 percentage of the students give good and 36% give very good opinion. But the balance 12% students only have average comments regarding the updation of knowledge and perspective in the subject area.

Graph II: Balance between theoretical and practical knowledge is essential for a good curriculum. Student's feedback regarding the same shows that most of them have very good and good comments. 40% rated for very good and 36 percentage voted for good option. But remaining 12% and 4% have only average and satisfactory opinion about the same.

Graph III: Rate of the curriculum must be adequate in terms of the load to the students. So the students were asked to make comments about the same. Fifty percentages of students have good and 25 per cent have very good opinion. Percentage of respondents give average and satisfactory is 12% and 8%. It indicate that curriculum have adequate size in terms in load to the students.

Graph IV: Students response about the structure of the curriculum indicates that majority of the student have good opinion. 40% and 36% give good and very good opinion respectively. Remaining students have average and satisfactory comments. It indicate that curriculum have well-structured to meet the programme/course outcome.

Graph V: Literary quality of the text books is essential for quality learning. Students have the opinion that prescribed text book and reference have very good literary quality as per syllabus. 40% and 32% give very good and good opinion. But the remaining 20 per cent have average opinion about the same.

Graph VI: Students were asked to make analysis about the ability of the curriculum to support higher learning. 32 percentage students have both very good and good opinion. Along with those 20% students tells excellent opinion about the potential of the curriculum to support higher learning. At the same time 16% only have average opinion.

Graph II: Results shows that majority of the students have the opinion that syllabus have a good balance between theoretical and practical knowledge. 67% and 33% give good and very good opinion respectively. It indicates that balance between theoretical and practical knowledge is excellent.

Graph III: Students feedback on the size of the curriculum shows remarkable results. All the students give good opinion about the same. Students tell that size of the curriculum is adequate in terms of load on the students.
