Graph I: first question that the teachers required to make their comments is related to whether the curriculum is need based or not. All the teachers give excellent, very good and good comments. 75 per cent teachers give very good and 13% give good opinion. Along with that remaining 12 percentage voted for excellent option. So it concludes that curriculum is need based.

Graph II: Graph represents the opinion of teachers regarding the match between the pedagogy proposed in the curriculum and the content. Majority (38) of the teacher's opinion that there is good match between pedagogy and content of the curriculum.37 percent and 25 percent teachers commented that there is very good and excellent match between these two.

Graph III: Well defined aims and objectives reflect the quality and standard of curriculum. So the teachers are asked to rate whether the aims and objectives are well defined and are of global standards. Among the total teachers feedback 63 percentage of teachers give both good and 37% give good opinion regarding the same.

Graph IV: Graph shows the teachers feedback regarding the balance between theory and application in the curriculum. Same percentage of teacher's commented that there is excellent and very good balance between theory and practical in the curriculum

Graph V: Regarding the inclusion of advanced topic in the curriculum, teacher's comments indicates that majority of them give good and very good comments. 75% and 12% give good and very good comments respectively. It concluded that curriculum includes advanced topic as per the feedback on teachers.

Graph VI: Without enough instructional hours teachers cannot complete the syllabus effectively. Teacher's comments on the availability of instructional hour's shows that majority of them have the opinion that enough instructional hours are available for completing the syllabus. 37% give good opinion and 37% give good opinion regarding the same. Remaining 38% only have average opinion.

Graph VII: Like the availability of the instructional hours teachers have very good opinion regarding the availability of reference text books and teaching resources. Results indicates that 50% have good and 37% have good opinion. But 13% teachers only have average opinion regarding the same.

Graph VIII: Teachers were asked to make analysis about the prospects of curriculum for higher education and employability. Results evidenced that 25% teachers give very good and 75% give good opinion regarding the same. It can be concluded from the results that curriculum has the prospects for higher education/employability.

Graph IX: Teachers are directed to make analysis on the scope of the curriculum for internship/training /research. Most of the teachers give good and very good comments. 37% give good and 50% give very good comment regarding the same. Final result shows that curriculum has the scope for internship/training/research.

Graph X: Habit of self-learning and applied learning is important among students. Teachers are asked to give their comments on the curriculum potential in developing the habit of self-learning. Most of them have good opinion. 50% have very good and good opinion about the same.

So the teachers were asked to make an analysis about the same. 755 give very good and 25% give good comments.
